ELIGIBILITY

General

Please refer to League Rule 15a.below

A player who is registered with any other senior league, or plays for their town, or their county, at any level other than Cadet, will not be eligible to enter the championships unless they have played at least five matches for their team in the league competition in the current season prior to the draw being made before the championships.

Restricted Singles

Players in the top 12 of the Division 1 averages will be excluded.
The committee reserves the right to vary these guidelines if appropriate.

Junior Singles (under 19)

Born 01 January 2007 or after.

Cadets Singles (under 15)

Born 01 January 2011 or after.

Veterans Singles

Born 01 January 1986 or before.

ANTICIPATED ORDER OF PLAY

We expect to start the event with the Doubles events, followed by the mens and ladies singles and other competitions.

Whenever possible we will attempt to ensure that no player faces unreasonable delays between matches.

ETIQUETTE

Winning and losing players may be required to umpire the next match.
