

Stowmarket Table Tennis Club - Code of Practice for Members



- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training, practice sessions, matches and competitions or inform the person responsible if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training sessions, matches and competitions.
- Members must pay any fees for training, practice sessions or matches.
- Members should always avoid inappropriate use of alcohol and tobacco, and never condone or take part in the use of any type of illegal or performance enhancing drugs
